The Saudi Healthcare Leadership Institute aims to prepare healthcare leaders to lead their organization in this rapidly-changing health care environment, by providing them with business and leadership strategies which can improve patient care, operational efficiency and overall success of initiatives.

The Saudi Health Care Leadership Institute is a partnership between the PAS Centre for International Health and the Saudi Critical Care Society. The Saudi HealthCare Leadership Institute will be offered as a modular program and will cover an array of topics including:

- Healthcare leadership
- Systems thinking
- Leadership skills
- Evidence based decision making
- Managing transformation and change
- Organizational and strategic planning
- Financial management and budget planning
- Human Resource planning
- Building high performance work cultures
- Health information management
- Performance measurement and management.

In each module participants will be exposed to the thinking and practice of internationally recognized healthcare and business leadership experts as well as a broad array of tools, strategies and methodologies. Each module will employ a variety of teaching techniques including lectures, small group learning to draw on personal experience in putting theory into practice and to develop a far deeper understanding of real-world challenges.

At the completion of each module participants will receive a certificate of completion and appropriate continuing education credits. Participants who complete four modules and a capstone project will be eligible to obtain a fellowship in health care leadership program.
